Here are 6 additional measures taken by Croisières AML that have been approved by public health to provide everyone with a magnificent whale-watching experience:

- 1) When boarding, all customers must answer a few short questions about their current medical condition, to ensure that they do not pose a risk factor for other passengers.
- 2) The wearing of a face cover is required for clients aged 3 years and over when boarding, as well as when distancing is not possible on board the boat.
- 3) We ensure compliance with distancing practices in line with Quebec public health directives.
- 4) We have adapted our catering operations both in terms of service and in the kitchen in order to scrupulously respect government instructions.
- 5) Hand disinfection is compulsory for each passenger when boarding and disembarking. We are also placing increased emphasis on disinfecting and sanitizing all key locations, both on the dock and on our boats.
- 6) Before each working day, all our employees must complete a health check.
